**Degree Requirements**

The requirements above lists the credits in each of the categories. While students transfer 24 or more credits to CUNY SPS, this degree map has been constructed to show the full curriculum.

**Notes:**

- Required number of College Option credits and free electives required will be based on the transfer credit evaluation. In general, students will be required to complete College Option credits and free electives as follows:

<b>Transfer with</b>	<b>College Option Credits</b>	<b>Free Elective Credits</b>
Associate Degree	6	39
More Than 30 Credits	9	36
30 or Fewer Credits	12	33

- Students who transfer a course that is an equivalent for any part of the curriculum will not be required to repeat the course.
- Students who take a course at CUNY SPS (or transfers a course) that satisfies both a Human Relations requirement and General Education requirement will have additional credits added to the required free electives.
- Four courses (12 credits) satisfy both program requirements as well as General Education requirements.

**Given these assumptions, the following is a likely breakdown of the credit distribution for completion of the degree:**
